Throughout the day, we kept crossing paths. Before Carl left, he asked if we would be attending the Rainbow Groups. That led to a drink later, where we talked openly about our experiences. It gave me support I had not realised I needed.

A year later, Carl and I live happily together with our children, supporting each other in ways few can understand.



We fundraise for Harry's Rainbow as a family and participate in events like the Colour Run. In 2023, Elcie was one of the top child fundraisers and received a special treat. She also carried the Baton of Hope for suicide awareness in honor of her daddy, Aston.



We visit Danielle's and Aston's headstones as a family and share stories. Though I never met Danielle, I feel like I know her through the boys' memories.

Harry's Rainbow has given Elcie and me invaluable support and opportunities, and I'll always be grateful. Through them, I met Carl, and we've shared incredible experiences, like our first family holiday at the Rainbow Retreat in Camber Sands.

Now, we take life one day at a time as a strong, loving family. I'm excited for the future with Carl and all our children including the newest addition, our baby girl who completes our family.
